

MINUTES of Deep Fork Valley Football Association Meeting

Meeting date: 6/8/2011

1. **Call to order:** A regular meeting of the DEEP FORK VALLEY FOOTBALL LEAGUE was held 1700 W. Independence, Shawnee, Oklahoma on June 8, 2011. The meeting convened at 6:41PM, President Kenneth Crawford presiding, and Jeremy Quarry, secretary.
2. **Members in attendance:** Chandler, Choctaw, Harrah, Jones, Luther, McLoud, Meeker, New Castle, CNP, Noble, Perkins, Prague, Seminole, Tecumseh and two members representing Yukon association.
Members not in attendance: Bethel ,Blanchard
3. **Officers' reports:**

Vice president Casey Martin
Secretary Jeremy Quarry
Treasurer Gary Knowles- posted a DFV financial report for all associations to review.
4. **Business:**

New business

- i) **New Association/Expansion committee chairman, Ty Norton**, opened the meeting by introducing Jim Stilwell and Mike Meadows of Yukon. Each association and officer introduced themselves. Mr. Meadows then expressed Yukon's interest in joining the DFVFL. He also presented a platform on which the Yukon association would adhere to the DFV by-laws and how the Yukon school district would be split into boundaries. Choctaw made the motion to allow Yukon to join the DFVFL with payment of the \$500 commitment fee. Motion seconded by Chandler. Motion passed 14-0. Yukon paid \$500 commitment fee.
- ii) Discussion was held on a player that participated in the DFV in 2010 illegally under DFV by-laws. He was given permission by a DVF officer under the assumption by the Seminole Coordinator that the player would be living in Seminole before the conclusion of the 2010 season, which did not occur. This issue was addressed in the final meeting of the 2010 season. No disciplinary action was taken due to the fact the Seminole coordinator had obtained permission through a DFV officer. It was also confirmed the player was still not eligible to play for Seminole as of June 8, 2011. A motion was made by Perkins to set an August 1st cutoff date for the player's eligibility to play at Seminole. Choctaw respectfully requested to amend the standing motion that extended the date to allow the player to be enrolled in Seminole Schools by the first day of the 2011 school year in order to be eligible to play at Seminole. Perkins agreed to Choctaw's request. Motion was seconded by Harrah. Motion passed 9 to 4 with 1 abstaining. The issue is to be revisited for the 2012 season.
- iii) Discussion was held confirming the Shawnee YMCA withdrawing their interest in joining the DFVLA. CNP made a motion to open up the Shawnee school districts up to Bethel, Meeker, and Prague. Allowing Bethel to acquire players from the Will Rogers, Jefferson, Sequoyah, and Horace Mann districts and allow Prague and Meeker to acquire players from North Rock Creek, South Rock Creek, Grove and Pleasant Grove Districts. The Liberty Academy would be split by address. Motion seconded by Prague. Motion passed 14-0.
- iv) A motion was made by Prague to allow DFV associations to participate in passing leagues

through July. In order to participate the association must notify the DFVLA. Motion seconded by Luther. Motion passed 11-2 with 1 abstaining.

- v) Reviewing the proposed by-laws was tabled until next meeting.
- vi) A decision on how to split association was tabled until next meeting.
- vii) Discussion on 2011 table until next meeting.
- viii) Choctaw provide a N.A.Y.S. brochure to each association to review.

Adjournment: July 20, 2011, 6:30PM at 1700 W. Independence, Shawnee Oklahoma, is the fixed time and place for the next DFV meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 8:42 PM.
